FAITHFUL FRIAR'S MESSAGE



RESURRECTION

The Gospels offer no proof of the Resurrection. There was no proof then and there is no proof now. The gospel does reveal signs of the Resurrection. The most significant sign was the empty tomb. The scene in the empty tomb was orderly. The disorder one would expect to be left by grave robbers, (then a common practice) is absent. If thieves took the body, they certainly would have taken it away wrapped up in the expensive cloths,

which could be sold. The gospel gives a tedious description of the burial cloth folded neatly and put aside. The head cloth placed in a location by itself. Later the many appearances of the risen Christ slowly began to teach the Apostles that Jesus had, indeed, risen from the dead. Although changed, he was alive and real. He was no longer the human historical Jesus. ---Risen, he was the human glorified Christ

The fourth gospel recalls a touching way the risen Lord came to the Apostles while they were fishing. The risen Lord called out to the Apostles from the shore: "children, have you caught any fish?" (jn. 21: 5). The Apostle John, immediately recognized Jesus---the word "children" was a clue.

At his last farewell to his Apostles Jesus addressed them as "little children" Jn. 13:33.... "little children, yet a little while I am with you...." Only Jesus had addressed them so. Calling the Apostles "children" links this Resurrection appearance with Jesus' farewell to his Apostles. John cried out! It's the Lord!" Overwhelmed with joy, Peter, jumped into the water and waded to shore. Peter, saw the fire which the risen Christ built to warm the Apostles. Then the risen Lord joined the Apostles to eat the breakfast he had cooked for them. For Christ was not a vision.

This Easter Season pray to our Lord for eyes and hearts that can recognize him when he shows himself to us in ordinary human ways. Be aware --- he comes to us disguised as others; and he comes to us disguised as ourselves.

Yes, there is no proof of the Resurrection. There are only signs. The Resurrection is a matter of faith. For those who believe, no explanation is necessary. For those who do not believe, no explanation is possible.
